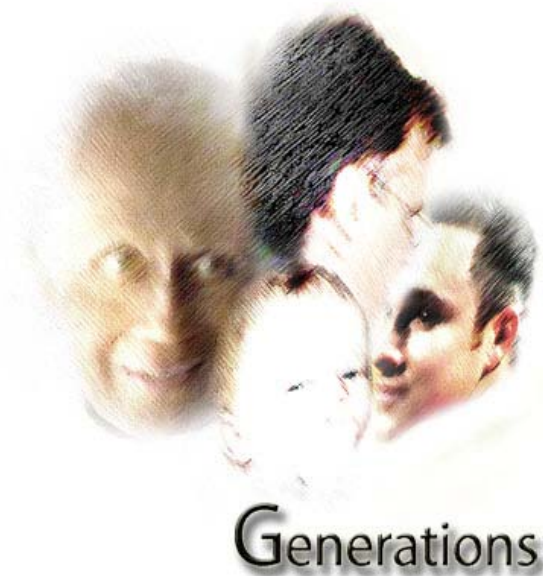

CONFERENCE DESCRIPTION

The Fall Conference offers a unique learning experience utilizing various modalities. Central to this conference will be the use of video materials. Didactic presentations, large plenary dialogue/sharing of work experience groups, and small process groups will all be utilized. Our goal is to provide a relaxed learning environment in which participants can integrate a deeper understanding of intergenerational issues into their group leadership style and clinical practice.

From Generation to Generation and Back Again

We will examine intergenerational issues in group psychotherapy. Issues that emerge between generations—the “sandwich generation” phenomenon, affiliation between grandchildren and grandparents, misunderstandings due to cultural shifts between generations, unresolved childhood conflicts manifested in mid-life and later, and multicultural and immigrant experiences—will be examined both experientially and through use of video materials from film and television. Small process groups will be central to understanding how these issues are manifested in groups.

Conference participants will be able to:

- Identify salient psychological issues facing their patients, themselves, and their therapy groups that relate to intergenerational phenomena, especially respect, envy, disdain, dependency and honor;
- Apply these concepts to clinical situations;
- Understand how these concepts impact society at large.
